

Wine List

Australian, White Wine

Yering Station Marsanne Viognier Rousne - \$75

Shows excellent weight with clean pear, peach, white stone fruit and orange flavour. Its creamy texture is supported by an integrated and balanced acid backbone. Long, focused finish.

Wolf Blass Unwooded Chardonnay - \$75

The unwooded Chardonnay is a light straw colour with hint of pale green in the glass. Summer tropical fruits of mango and peach. These fruity flavours are balanced by the clean acidity and good length of this wine.

Yellow Tail Chardonnay - \$45

A golden straw colour chardonnay with ripe peach and melon aromas and sweet oak nuances. The palate is fresh and approachable with balanced acidity and lingering tropical fruit finish.

Canyon Road Sauvignon Blanc - \$48

Luscious, deep scents of lemon grass, grapefruit and passion fruit. A lively palate full of crisp acids provides a zesty finish



Australian, Red Wine

Yering Station Shiraz Viognier - \$85

Rich and elegant with floral aromas, blackberry and spicy cool climate characters. Fine tannins with a silky and supple finish.

Yellow Tail Shiraz - \$45

Full-bodied, generous, ripe fruit characters with underlying earthy tones and lingering sweet berry flavours. A touch of vanillin oak adds balance and softness to the long, enjoyable finish.



New Zealand, Red Wine

Matua Marlborough Pinot Noir - \$85

Fragrant and soft, with aromas of ripe cherries and plums. Gentle sweet fruit tannins to provide serious structure and length.



California, Red Wine

Canyon Road Merlot - \$48

Plum and black cherry aromas are at the center of a rich bouquet that is complemented by slight oak and vanilla tones. The palate is soft, approachable and fruity.



Australian, Sparkling Wine

Jacob's Creek Chardonnay Pinot Noir (N.V) - \$80

Mid straw green with a fine and persistent mousse.

The citrus and toasted cashew nut flavour of Chardonnay compliment the fresh breadcrumb character of Pinot Noir. Elegant fruit scent enhanced with creamy yeast provides depth and flavour. The wine finishes soft, crisp and clean.



French, Champagne

Piper Heidsieck Brut (N.V) - \$135

Pale gold in colour, an assertive bubbly with light aromas of citrus fruits and spring flowers.

Moet Et Chandon (N.V) - \$180

Golden-yellow colour with amber reflections, with fresh floral aromas and hazelnut, smooth and peachy on the finish.
